


ACTIVITY #1 TITLE	LEARNING GOAL/OBJECTIVE	MATERIALS






ACTIVITY #3 TITLE	LEARNING GOAL/OBJECTIVE	MATERIALS

This kitty said, "Meow, meow, I saw him go through This hole just now."





Make puppies from brown lunch bags. Let the child draw the face on the bag and glue on ears.


