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2023 IMPACT REPORT

In 2023, JP Brooklyn found a new home.

After two years of significant growth, our Brooklyn program needed a new space for our growing staff, families, and community partners. In Spring 2023, we moved into a new space with a dedicated kids' play area. The new downtown Brooklyn office sits at the nexus of resources important to our families, including the Human Resources Administration office that provides assistance with SNAP and housing. We celebrated with an open house that included a ribbon-cutting ceremony with the Brooklyn Chamber of Commerce and a conversation with JP's president and CEO and several JP Brooklyn moms. Our new space has become a hub for families — bringing moms and kids together for monthly Sisterhood Hours and events while also offering a beautiful area for families to connect, play, and study together. Single mother sisterhood sustains women and families in pursuit of economic mobility. Throughout 2023, 76% of moms persisted in their college, career, and leadership journeys — and with JP Brooklyn.
