In 2025 at JP, we sharpened our focus on strengthening outcomes for single mothers who are student parents as rising costs and changes in public assistance intensified pressures on them. Despite these challenges, 12 moms earned their degrees, including nine moms in the spring — the largest class JP Fargo-Moorhead has celebrated! Two JP teachers graduated with early childhood education degrees, and 100% of families participated in summer enrichment programming. Your partnership made this progress possible, ensuring JP could meet the moment and advance the success of single moms across the Fargo-Moorhead community.

AN AVERAGE OF 90% OF AGE-APPROPRIATE JP KIDS were kindergarten-ready, laying a strong foundation for academic success.

\$97K+ INVESTED IN 529 ACCOUNTS FOR JP KIDS, making them three times more likely to enroll in college and four times more likely to graduate.

89% OF ELIGIBLE JP KIDS participated in JP-funded summer child care and enrichment programming.

97% OF FAMILIES who received JP-funded tutoring observed progress in their children's academic performance.

80% OF JP ALUMNI REPORTED FULL-TIME EMPLOYMENT, and 30% have or are pursuing additional post-secondary degrees.

\$55K IS THE MEDIAN INCOME FOR JP ALUMNI, which is 71% above the federal poverty level for a family of four.
